Getting Ready for School: Dress Code

- Responsible attire

- Zero tolerance for bullying
- Cell phones muted and kept in safe place
- Pink hall pass required to be in the hall
- Nurse visits with permission
- Respect the red lines
- No hands on other kids
- Walk in hallways



Before School

- Students may arrive to the Multi-Purpose Room at 7:30 am
 - Drop backpack at classroom or keep with you
- Breakfast served at 7:45 am
- Morning recess begins at 8:00 am bell
- Bells:
 - Intermediate bell at 8:15 am, WALK to class
 - Primary bell at 8:30 am, WALK on blacktop to class line
 - Arrivals to school after the bell, check in at office for late pass

Morning Snack Recess

- For your safety- no food on playground
- Snacks to be eaten along the wall
- Throw away all garbage
- Respect the red lines, play only on playground (not bathrooms, courtyard)
- Play stops at the bell, hold the balls WALK on blacktop
- Balls in cart

How to Walk (and Wait) in Line

- Single file
- Walking is walking, not skipping, twirling, jumping, jogging...
- Leave space in front of doors for others to enter and exit
- No cuts
- Hands to yourself
- Stand
- Inside voices

Lunchtime Code of Conduct

- Classes excused together, line up and stay together
- WALK to lunch or be sent to the back of the line!
- Lunch is not playtime no games in line or horsing around
- Sit while eating
- Low voices
- Food is meant to be eaten, not thrown
- Be selfish! (Don't share your food!)
- Raise your hand to be excused at the bell
- Clear all garbage from tables

Courtyard Code

Be Safe

- WALK (don't run, don't skip)
- Avoid yellow lines around doorways
- Don't twirl on poles
- Rocks, bark, sand, sticks stay on the ground
- Be Respectful
 - Benches are for sitting (not hurdles, not stepstools)
 - Planter boxes are not shortcuts, walk around
 - Reasonable voices
 - Don't bounce balls
 - Clean up all trash We're all RESPONSIBLE for our school

Recess! Keep it fun!

Be Safe

- Heads up! Don't let others get hit with your flying balls
- Use equipment for its intended purposes (ropes, hoops, swings, structures)
- No tag on play structures
- Restrooms for intended purpose only no playing, hanging out
- Games with kids as targets are not allowed
- Be Respectful
 - Don't kick, knock balls away from your classmates
 - Don't kick, throw balls against buildings
- Be Responsible
 - Bring in all balls after recess

Rules Keep Games Safe & Fun for All

Ball guidelines

- No kicking balls on blacktop kick balls in field
- Equipment available first-come-first-served
- NO balls from home
- Put ball back in bin if you're done playing with it
- Collect all balls at the end of recess, Eagle Eyes for helpers
- Blacktop Games
 - Tetherball
 - 4 Square & 9 Square
 - Wall ball games stay within boundaries
 - Basketball

Boundaries

Red lines

- Stay where yard duty can see you
 - Not behind trees or buildings
 - Keep away from bike racks and Kindergarten playground
 - Get permission/hall pass to leave playground
 - No kids in ball room ever!
- Homework space
- Designated fields for sports
 - Soccer field with goalposts
 - Football beyond soccer field (touch only)
 - Baseball & softball

Games Are Open to All: First Come, First Served

- Tetherball
 - Server chooses their half of the court, and chooses direction of play
 - No touching the rope even by accident or the pole at any time
 - Clean hits only, no volleyball taps or setting to yourself, no holds
 - If you whiff and the ball hits the pole and stays on your side, hit it again
 - Play hard, no "easies"
 - First person in line is the judge when players disagree
 - Three (3) wins then out!
- Four-Square
 - Server is the judge and makes the rules
 - Hit the ball in your opponents square if you miss the square, you're out

After School

- No school equipment after school
- Go directly to your pick-up point
- Bikes, scooters (anything with wheels) must be walked on school grounds
- Students must leave campus or have parental supervision after 2:45 pm
 - Supervisors may send you home immediately after school if misbehaving
- Be SAFE in the parking lot!
 - Cross only in crosswalks WALK!
